Program Content:	The course is comprised of the entire workflow in the 3D animation pipeline using computer generated objects and environments. Course content includes creation of models, polygonal structure of both mechanical and organic models, surfacing and texturing, loading modules into software and lighting and animating models. Students will also learn how to create worlds for the models to reside and the compositing process for real world video interaction. This program also encompasses video production techniques, camera fundamentals and use, DVD and Blu-ray authoring, studio production with an emphasis on chroma-key technology. A web portfolio that demonstrates the student's skills will be completed.
