Placement Test

You must take a Placement Test (TABE) before you can enroll in classes. Schedule the test at the Office of Student Records. Then, take the test.

What is my Username?

Your Username is your 6-digit Student Number

What is my Password?

Your password is:

The first two letters of your first name, lower case (no spaces).

The first three #s of your user ID (no spaces).

The first two letters of your last name (no spaces).

Then MTC!

For example, for John Lewis with a user ID of 12346,
the password is jo123leMTC!

How To Begin

Visit # 1

1. Complete the Online Application

(at home or MTC Main Campus Student Services)
<https://www.ManateeTech.edu/apply-now>

2. Bring your photo ID to Student Services

(For example, FL Driver's License, Passport, etc.)

3 Schedule Session #1 of TABE test

(Office of Student Records at Student Services Room 1-1706)

4. Discuss class options with Pre-enrollment Counselor

(walk-in basis at Front Desk)

Visit #2

1. Take Session #1 of TABE Test

Testing Center/Room 1123.
(Test to determine your level-40 minutes/Math—70 minutes)

2. Schedule Session #2 after you finish Session #1:

Schedule at the Office of Student Records in Room 1-1706 at Student Services.

3. Contact a Counselor to schedule an appointment to meet with a Counselor AFTER Session #2.

Visit #3/4

1. Take TABE Session #2 (Reading--2 hours)

2. Meet with Counselor to be enrolled in class

(appointment made previously—sometimes not on same day as Session #2)

3. Take the receipt you received from the Counselor to the Book Store to get a photo ID, a parking tag for your car and an MTC t-shirt (\$10 each).

Start Classes

Your Counselor will give you a detailed copy of your schedule. Please bring it with you on the first day of class.

1. Create an account at <http://ged.com/>

2. Provide MTC the following:

* A copy of the official withdrawal paper from your last High School attended
