2029 Vision for Educational Programs

In the year 2029, all Manatee Technical College programs are competitively filled based on factors recognized as predictors of success for the specific program. All programs will have a completion rate of 80 percent or higher. All programs will have a licensure pass rate of 90 percent or higher or a student industry-certification rate of 90 percent or higher. All programs will have a placement rate of 90 percent or higher.

- Strategies for Achieving this Objective
 - Use exit surveys completed by current students for program improvement to increase student retention
 - Use national program certifications for program improvement
 - O Strengthen school's placement and follow-up program
 - o Conduct a comprehensive local needs assessment to ensure programs are adequate in size, scope and quality and aligned with local labor market needs.
 - o Increase Hybrid and Distance Learning programs to meet the needs of our students and community.
 - o Students will be given co-curricular opportunities to enhance and further their leadership and employability skills through SkillsUSA and HOSA.
- Strategies for Evaluating Progress toward Achieving this Objective
 - Verify the enrollment in each program
 - Verify the completion rate annually of each program
 - o Verify the placement rate annually of each program
 - Verify the industry certifications earned and/or licensure pass rate of each program annually
 - o Find creative funding resources to support both Hybrid and Distance Learning.
 - o Monitor the growth of student population participation in SkillsUSA and HOSA.

2029 Vision for Physical Resources

In the year 2029, Manatee Technical College will be housed in state-of-the-art facilities in the east and central part of the county.

- Strategies for Achieving this Objective
 - o The state-of-the-art facilities currently exist at the Main Campus on State Road 70 East and at MTC East on Lakewood Ranch Blvd.
 - By the year 2025, there is a Florida Department of Law Enforcement certified driving facility
 - o By the year 2025, Florida Department of Law Enforcement certified training facility including the firing range and driving pad are completed
 - o By the year 2028, there is a permanent, state-of-the-art addition for MTC to accommodate new workforce education programs, a dedicated skills and industry certification testing center, and Adult General Education classes.
 - By the year 2028, MTC will implement at least one aviation/avionics program.
- Strategies for Evaluating Progress toward Achieving this Objective
 - o The funding and building of each facility
- Status Report April 2024: MTC currently has excellent facilities for career-technical programs at MTC Main and MTC East. The MTC Main Campus currently houses Adult General Education.
 - The new Law Enforcement training facility is moving forward and should be open Spring of 2025. Aviation facility received 5.5 million from Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) and has another 2.2 million pending from the Department of Commerce
 - The efforts for the MTC expansion are on hold due to no additional allocations from the 2024 legislative session.

2029 Vision for Human Resources

In the year 2029, Manatee Technical College will be fully staffed to provide the services, programs, and leadership for the college.

- Strategies for Achieving this Objective
 - o Establish a MTC staffing model based on enrollment and diversity that is approved by Board of Governors, District Administration, and School Board.

 - Compare proposed model to current staffing
